- (1) Phoneaid is designated as an ETC for the entire service area of Bellsouth Telecommunications, Inc.
- (2) During the current certification period, Phoneaid shall be eligible to receive federal Universal Service Fund support for only low-income support.
- (3) Phoneaid shall offer low-income universal support service to consumers in its service area.
- (4) Phoneaid shall offer these services using its own facilities.
- (5) Phoneaid shall be precluded from offering universal service support exclusively through the resale of another carrier's services.
- (6) Phoneaid shall advertise the availability of and charges for these services using media of general distribution.
- (7) Phoneaid shall file a separate petition for the extension of its ETC designation for other areas of universal service support.
- (8) By September 1, 2010, and by each September 1 thereafter, Phoneaid shall make its annual certification filing in Administrative Case No. 381.
- (9) A copy of this Order shall be served upon the FCC and the Universal Service Administrative Company.
