- (5) Pursuant to KRS 278.360, the record of the formal hearing shall be by videotape.
- (6) Commission Staff shall make a written exhibit list and file list with the commission.
- (7) On or before November 21, 2011, each party shall file with the Commission a list of the witnesses it expects to call at the formal hearing and a summary of their expected testimony.
- (8) On or before November 4, 2011, a party may serve requests for information upon any opposing party.
- (9) Service of any document shall be made in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(7).
- (10) Any party filing a document with the Commission shall serve such document upon all other parties.
- (11) Any document a party serves upon the other parties shall be filed with the Commission.
- (12) The Complainant bears the burden of proof, his failure to appear may result in the dismissal of his complaint.
- (13) The failure of the Defendant to appear may result in an Order granting the Complainant's requested relief.
