1. The Applicant is granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a wireless telecommunications facility. The proposed facility consists of a self-supporting antenna tower not to exceed 310 feet in height, with attached antenna, and is to be located on a tract of land approximately 2.1 miles southwest of the Perry/Leslie County line on the Hal Rogers Parkway, Dry Hill, Leslie County, Kentucky. The coordinates for the proposed facility are North Latitude 37° 13' 21" by West Longitude 83° 22' 8.4".
