Kentucky Power's proposal to refund \$32,673.62 to customers in the first FAC filing following the date of this Order is approved. 3. Kentucky Power shall immediately begin limiting the recovery of fuel costs through the FAC during a forced outage to the lesser of the assigned cost of power and the substitute cost of power and cease utilizing the peaking unit equivalent in its calculation.
