LG&E/KU's application review fees of \$75 for wireline attachments and \$200.00 for wireless attachments are approved as proposed, but in an effort to be fully transparent, LG&E/KU shall add language to their tariffs indicating that the application review fees will be refunded or credited to the new attacher if the amount of the prepayment of application review fees exceeds the actual costs of the work performed by LG&E/KU; c.
