This proceeding is initiated to determine the amortization period and deferral mechanism for the Rockport Deferral Regulatory Asset, and the credit for the Rockport Fixed Costs Savings and Rockport Offset. 2. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed. 3. Within seven days of service of this Order, Kentucky Power shall file its proposal for the amortization period and recovery mechanism of the Rockport Deferral Regulatory Asset and the credit for the Rockport Fixed Costs Savings and Rockport Offset, supported by testimony. 4. The Attorney General and KIUC are made parties to this proceeding. 5. Any party filing documents with the Commission shall serve a copy of those documents upon all other parties. Unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, the procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, related to service and electronic filing of papers shall be followed in this proceeding.
