# Determination of Billing Demand:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

#### Power Factor Adjustment:

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practical. At the discretion of the seller, demand charges will be adjusted for consumers with 25 kw or more of measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 85% and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the seller deems it necessary.

Average power factor shall be the cosine of the angle determined by the tangent formed by the kilovar hours metered each month divided by the kilowatt hours metered to the consumer for the same period.

When the average power factor is below 85% such adjustment shall be made by multiplying the registered kw demand times the ratio of 85% divided by the average power factor in percent as determined above.

#### Minimum Charge:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges:

(a) The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract service MMISSION

(b) A charge of \$0.75 per K.V.A. per month of contract capacity.

#### Fuel Cost Adjustment Charge

In case the rate under which seller purchases power at wholesale i adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller s wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted RING DIVISION each month by the same amount per KWHR as the fuel cost adjustment per KWHR in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

## LARGE POWER RATE (LP-R)


### Conditions of Service

- (1) Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.
  - (2) Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate.
- (3) All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
- (4) If service is furnished at Sellers primary line voltage, a discount of five percent (5%) shall apply to the demand and energy charges, and if the minimum harge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of 5% shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, the Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage and adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt hours and kilowatt demand.

#### Terms of Payment

The above rates are net and payable within 15 days from the date of the bill.

For service from dusk to midnight, a discount of 10% of the Base Rate shall be allowed.

## Additional Charges:

The above charges apply to lamps mounted on brackets on existing poles of the Cooperative and where no additional poles are required for street lighting circuits. A charge of \$2.00 per year will be added to the total charge as determined above for each additional pole required.

## Minimum Charge:

The above rates are net, the gross rates being five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen (15) days from the date of the bill, the gross rates shall apply.

## Special Rules:

- 1. Street-lighting equipment including lamps, fixtures, time switch and the necessary street-lighting circuits, transformers, and additional guys and fittings will be furnished by the Cooperative.
- 2. Lamp replacements will be made by the . Any lamps replaced by the Cooperative will be charged to the Village at cost as a separate item on the monthly bill for service.
- 3. Service will be furnished for future additional lamps in accordance with the above charges provided no such lamp requires more than 1000 feet to be added to the street-lighting circuit. The average spacing between lamps shall be recomputed to include the additional lamps.
