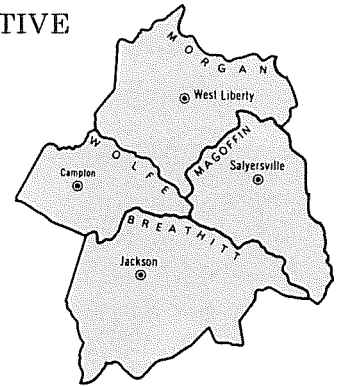



1. Consumers having their homes on the same premises with their business establishments may include service to both on the same meter in which cases all service will be billed under this schedule. If the consumer prefers, he may make provisions for two meters, in which case his usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential schedule and his use for business will be billed under this schedule and rate.

<p>CONDITION OF SERVICE:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase. Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rates; if a separate meter is required for the lighting circuit, the registration of the two watt hour meter shall be added to obtain total kWh used and the registration of the two demand meters shall be added to obtain total kilowatt demand for the billing purposes. All wiring, poles, lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by consumer. If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of ten percent (10%) shall apply to the minimum charge.
