SCHEDULE A - FARM AND HOME SERVICE

RATE PER UNIT

APPLICABLE:

All territory served (Morgan, Wolfe, Magoffin, and Breathitt Counties, Kentucky)

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE:

Available to members of the Corporation for all farm and home uses, subject to its established rules and regulations.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single-phase, 60 cycle, *120/240 volt*

RATES:

First 22 KWH or less, per month @	\$2.50
Next 28 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.065
Next 50 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.04
Next 100 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.025
Over 200 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.0175

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.50 where 3 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For members requiring more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of \$0.75 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum charge entitle the member in all cases to the use of the number of KWH corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rates.

DELAYED PAYMENT CHARGE:

The above rates are net, the gross being five percent (5%) higher, In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within twenty (20) days from the date of the bill, the gross rates shall apply.

SPECIAL RULES:

Service under this schedule is limited to individual motors up to and including ten horsepower (10 H.P.)

SCHEDULE B - COMMERCIAL AND SMALL POWER SERVICE

RATE PER UNIT

APPLICABLE:

All territory served (Morgan, Wolfe, Magoffin, and Breathitt Counties, Kentucky)

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE:

Available to commercial consumers, small industrial consumers and three-phase farm consumers for all uses including lighting, appliances, cooking heating and motors, all subject to the established rules and regulations of the Corporation covering this service.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single-phase, and three-phase where available, 60 cycle, 120/240V.

RATES:

First 22 KWH or less per month @	\$2.50
Next 28 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.065
Next 50 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.04
Next 2900 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.025
Over 3000 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.0175

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.50 where 3 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumer requiring more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required.

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGE FOR SEASONAL SERVICE:

Customers requiring service during not to exceed nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

TEMPORARY SERVICE:

Temporary service shall be applied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that there shall be an additional charge of \$1.25 for each month or fraction thereof that service is connected. Bills will not be pro-rated for a fractional part of a month.

<p>DELAYED PAYMENT CHARGE: The above rates are net, the gross being five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within twenty (20) days from the date of the bill, the gross rates shall apply.</p> <p>SPECIAL RULES:</p> <p>(a) Consumers having their homes on the same premises with their business establishments may include service to both on the same meter in which cases all service will be billed under this schedule. If the consumer prefers he may make provisions for two meters, in which case his usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential schedule, and his use for business will be billed under this schedule and rate.</p> <p>(b) Service under this schedule is limited to consumers whose load requirements can be met by transformers having a capacity not to exceed 15 KVA. Consumers requiring more than 15 KVA shall be served under an appropriate schedule for large power service.</p> <p>(c) The rated capacity of single-phase motors shall not be in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.)</p> <p>(d) Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.</p>

Next 28 KWH per Month, per KWH @	0.065
Next 50 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.04
Next 100 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.025
Over 200 KWH per month, per KWH @	0.0175
MINIMUM CHARGE: The minimum annual charge under the above rate shall be \$18.00 where 3 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum annual charge shall be increased at the rate of \$9.00 for each KVA or fraction thereof.	
DELAYED PAYMENT CHARGE: The above rates are net, the gross being five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within twenty (20) days from the date of the bill, the gross rates shall apply.	
SPECIAL RULES: In case three phase service is required, Schedule B shall apply.

SCHEDULE FOR LARGE POWER SERVICE

RATE PER UNIT

APPLICABLE:

All territory served (Morgan, Wolfe, Magoffin, Breathitt, Lee and Meniffee Counties, Kentucky.)

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE:

Available to consumers located on or near Seller's three-phase line for all type of usage, subject to the established rules and regulations of Seller.

RATES:

Per month per KW of billing	\$1.25
plus energy charges as follow:	
First 50 KWH used per month per KW of billing demand	0.025
Next 100 KWH used per month per KW of billing demand	0.015
For all remaining KWH used per month.	0.013

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as following:

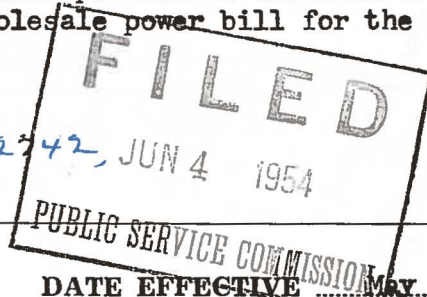
POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT:

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted for the consumer with 50 KW or more of measured demand to correct for average power factor lower than 90%, and may be so adjusted for other consumers of and when the Seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGES:

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWH as the fuel cost adjustment per KWH in the Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

RATE PER UNIT

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question.

- (1) The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service.
- (2) A charge of \$0.75 per KWA of installed transformer capacity.
- (3) A charge of \$25.00

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGE FOR THE SEASONAL SERVICE:

Consumer requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

Type OF SERVICE:

Three- phase, 60 cycles, at Seller's Standard voltages.

CONDITION OF SERVICE:

- 1. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower must be three -phase.
- 2. Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rates; if a separate meter is required for the lighting circuit, the registration of the two watt hour meter shall be added to obtain total KWH used and the registration of the two demand meters shall be added to obtain the total Kilowatt demand for the billing purposes.
- 3. All wiring, poles lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by consumer.
- 4. If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of ten per-cent (10%) shall be apply to the demand and energy charges, and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of 10% shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, the Seller shall have the option of metering a secondary voltage and adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered KWH and Kilowatt demand.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

The above rates are net, the gross rates being 10% higher on the first \$25.00 and 2% on the remainder of the bill. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen (15) days from the date of the bill, the gross rate shall be applied.
