
P. S. C. OF KY. ELECTRIC NO. 2

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Fuel Clause

Applicable to: All rate schedules in this Tariff other than Rate OL.

The monthly amount computed in accordance with the provisions of each of the rate schedules to which this fuel clause is applicable shall be increased or decreased at the rate of .103 mill (.0103¢) per kilowatthour of monthly consumption for each one cent per million Btu by which the average cost of fuel consumed during the second preceding month is more or less respectively than 33.8¢ per million Btu. The average cost of fuel consumed during any month shall be determined by dividing the total charges to the Fuel expense accounts during such month by the number of millions of Btu consumed; provided, however, that such average cost will be reduced to the extent that fuel purchased at higher than average cost is consumed in the production of energy for sale to other electric utility companies and is used as the basis of charging such other electric utility companies. The increase or decrease shall be made in direct proportion to the difference from the base fuel cost of 33.8¢ per million Btu, including differences of fractional parts of a cent.
