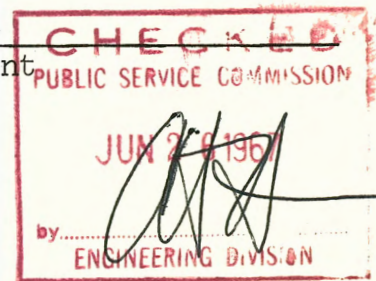

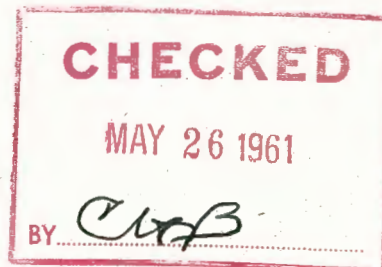
RULES AND REGULATIONS
(Cont'd.)

- VII. Upon compliance with the foregoing provisions, the Company will extend its distribution mains without cost up to but not more than a distance of two hundred (200) feet for each prospective domestic customer who agrees to utilize gas as the major source of energy for air conditioning, space heating and water heating.
- VIII. If service is discontinued at the request of any customer, the Company may refuse service to such customer, at the same premises, within eight (8) months, unless it shall first receive payment of Five Dollars (\$5.00) reconnection charge.

Available for general residential, commercial and industrial service. This Rate Schedule is not available for the purchase from Seller of natural gas to be used by Buyer as boiler fuel in an amount exceeding two thousand (2,000) Mcf on any one day; provided, however, that this limitation shall not apply to gas used to provide space heating or air-conditioning.

The rates authorized herein are based upon the wholesale cost of gas to the Applicant as computed upon rates of its wholesale suppliers then currently in effect as of November 1, 1965 under Federal Power Commission tariffs for interstate business or under wholesale tariffs of this Commission. The rates paid by the Applicant to its supplier as of November 1, 1965 are:

- (a) Rate Schedule CDS-1 - Contract Demand Service
 - Demand Charge
 - \$2.15 per Mcf of Billing Demand, per month,
 - Commodity Charge
 - 27.75¢ per Mcf:
 - (1) for all gas delivered hereunder each billing month,
 - (2) for the applicable monthly volumes nominated in accordance with Section 6 of Seller's Rate Schedule WS;

- (b) Rate Schedule WS - Winter Service
 - Demand Charge
 - \$0.65 per Mcf of Billing Demand each month of the year,
 - Contract Quantity Charge
 - 1.0¢ per Mcf of Winter Contract Quantity each month of the year.

For the purpose of this purchased gas adjustment clause, these rates shall be considered as the base rates for purchased gas. In the event there is an increase in these base rates, the Applicant shall within thirty days from the time it receives notice of the proposed change file with this Commission the following information:

- (1) A copy of the Federal Power Commission tariff or wholesale tariff of this Commission effecting the change in the base rates and a statement relative to the effective date of such proposed change.
