

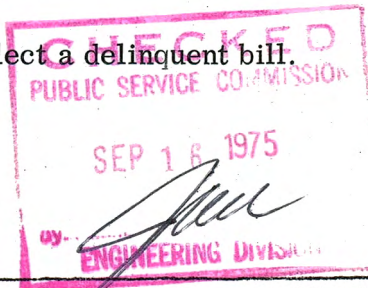

RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS WITH REFERENCE TO RATE SCHEDULES

1. Unless otherwise specified, a domestic, commercial or industrial consumer shall be interpreted to mean a customer served through an individual meter.
2. A multiple unit dwelling shall be interpreted to mean two or more consumers or dwelling units, such as apartments, trailers or mobile homes within a trailer park.
3. A master meter shall be interpreted to mean one meter servicing a trailer or mobile home park or a multiple unit dwelling; the Company reserves the right to charge a minimum monthly rate per mobile home or trailer or individual consumer within a multiple unit dwelling served through a master meter.
4. Anytime a master meter is used for rendering service, the Company shall require the execution of a service agreement in writing, which agreement among other things, shall specify the number of customers served through such master meter.
5. "MCF" is defined as 1,000 cubic feet at the measurement base.
6. Measurement Base: The unit of measurement shall be a MCF at a pressure base of 14.65 p. sia. a temperature of 60°F. and 0.6 specific gravity, having approximately 1,000 B. T. U. content per cubic foot.
7. "Service Area" is defined as any area supplied from one connection with the Company's supplier, i. e., Nicholasville-Wilmore is one service area as one connection from Tennessee Gas Piepline Company supplies both communities.
8. All rates of the Company are subject to Purchased Gas Adjustment Clause as approved by the Public Service Commission.
9. Terms of payment: All bills are due and payable in ten (10) days.
10. Delinquent Bill Charge: A charge of \$2.60 will be made to collect a delinquent bill. (T)
11. Reconnection Charge: Reconnection charge will be \$9.00.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. COMMISSION'S RULES AND REGULATIONS:

All gas service rendered by the Company shall be in accordance with the "Rules and Regulations for the Government of Gas Utilities" which have been adopted by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof which may be made by the Commission.

2. COMPANY'S RULES AND REGULATIONS:

In addition to the Rules and Regulations prescribed by the Public Service Commission, all gas service rendered shall also be in accordance with the following Rules and Regulations adopted by the Company, provided same do not conflict with those of the Public Service Commission.

3. FILING OF RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS:

A copy of all schedules of rates, rules and regulations under which gas service is rendered is on file for the public's benefit with the Public Service Commission of Kentucky and in the various offices of the Company.

4. APPLICATIONS FOR SERVICE:

C-2-76

All applications for service shall be made on the Company's standard application form; or a service agreement or service contract shall be properly executed by the customer or his duly authorized agent and accepted by the Company before any service is rendered. The Company will provide natural gas service within three (3) normal working days from the date of application, providing the company has adequate existing facilities and an adequate supply of gas available to render satisfactory service to meet the requirements of the applicant, and also providing the customer has properly installed his facilities in accordance with the Company's Rules and Regulations, including compliance with the ASA Z21.30-1964 code and can certify that he has complied with a pressure test meeting the Company's requirements.

A separate application or contract shall be made for each class of service at each separate location.

In cases where unusual construction or equipment expense is necessary to furnish the service, the Company may require a service contract for a minimum period of one (1) year.

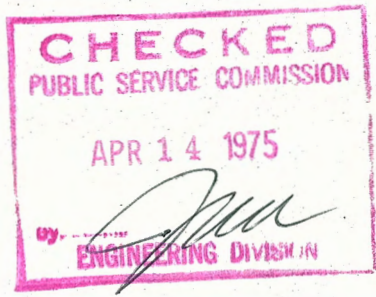
Residential: Service to customers which consists of direct natural gas usage in a residential dwelling for space heating, air conditioning, cooking, water heating, and other residential uses.

- (a) Small Commercial - Usage of up to 50 MCF per day.
- (b) Large Commercial - Usage of 50 MCF or more per day.

Industrial: Service to customers engaged primarily in a process which creates or changes raw or unfinished materials into another form or product including the generation of electric power.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

5. OWNER'S CONSENT TO OCCUPY:

In case the customer is not the owner of the premises or of the intervening property between the premises and the Company's service connection, it shall be the customer's responsibility to obtain from the property owner or owners the necessary consent to install and maintain in, on or over said premises all such piping and other equipment as are required or necessary for supplying gas service to the customer whether the piping and equipment be the property of the customer or the Company.

6. SERVICE DEPOSITS:

The Company may require from any or all customers as a guaranty or security, a cash deposit in an amount of up to two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual revenue.

Interest will be paid at the rate of six (6%) percent annually upon return of the deposit for the period between the deposit date and the date service is discontinued. The original service deposit receipt should be presented when demand is made for payment of interest or refund of deposit.

7. ACCESS TO PREMISES:

C 2-74

The Company shall have the right of access to the customer's premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of installing, reading, inspecting, repairing or removing its meters, regulators or other equipment used in connection with its supply of gas service or for the purpose of turning on or shutting off the gas supply when necessary and for all other proper purposes.

8. COMPANY'S EQUIPMENT AND INSTALLATION:

The Company shall furnish, install and maintain at its expense the necessary service connection. The location of this service connection will be made at the discretion and judgment of the Company.

The Company will furnish, install and maintain at its expense the necessary meter, regulator and connections which will be located at or near the main service connection, property line or near the building, at the discretion or judgment of the Company. Whenever practical, in the judgment of the Company, the location will be as near the supply main as possible and outside of buildings. Suitable site or location for the meter, regulator and
