Long Distance Wholesale Club ("LDWC") respectfully submits an original and five (5) copies of this letter to request approval from the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to cancel the Company's Certificate of Authority.

By way of background, LDWC was granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services within Kentucky on May 14, 1996 pursuant to Case Number 96-122. The Company ceased its long distance operations during the first quarter of 2000 following the transfer of its customer base to Excel Telecommunications, Inc.

Please note that since the Company has no subscriber base, the cancellation of its certificate does not adversely impact any Kentucky residents.
