Rhythms Links, Inc. ("Rhythms") hereby formally requests cancellation of its Utility Certificate and tariff by the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission").

Rhythms filed a Notice of Intent and Request for Certification in Kentucky on May 4, 1999. Rhythms subsequently provided Digital Subscriber Line ("DSL") services throughout the state.

Due to financial difficulties, Rhythms and its parent company, Rhythms NetConnections Inc., voluntarily filed for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the Southern District of New York on August 1, 2001. As no additional financing was obtained to maintain operations by the August 10th deadline stipulated in the Bankruptcy filing and a restructuring of the company was not deemed possible, discontinuance of service and cancellation of Rhythms' certificates is necessary. On August 10, 2001, all of Rhythms' customers received written notification of the company's intent to discontinue services. On September 24, 2001, the Federal Communications Commission granted Rhythms permission to discontinue providing domestic telecommunications services throughout the United States

As Rhythms no longer remains a "going concern" in Kentucky, and currently has no customers in the state, the company respectfully requests that the Commission cancel its Utility Certificate and tariff effective immediately.
